1. DIGEST OF POLITICAL SITUATION

- a. Henry R. Malament is leaving TPCREDO this week end. He claims his return to MTOURIO was delayed because he wanted to see the Malediet secretary who returned yesterday from BGBIDDY. Halament intimates that the IRCROWNS are up to some sort of deal with which the PRPRIMES are not familiar. (No comment.)
- b. This same suggestion has been made by Pashley and has been skirted in a preliminary way by Meell. From what the writer is able to piece together the ZRCROWNS seem concerned with strengthening their post-war position. (No comment.) It has been unofficially reported to familiar with your country -- we had missions in Pixieland during the last war. We understand you and for centuries we have been doing this sort of work. Unfortunately, this quotation can not be used without serious repersussions for the man who informed the writer. COMMENT: It does appear to the writer that ______is making every effort to gain favor with the Pixies. I would not attempt to say whether or not this is on his own or on orders.
- c. It is reliably reported that Orness is gathering strong backing for the splinter movement. It is claimed that the following are openly backing Orness in HTMEIGH: Tevell, Whiffen, Newlyn, Ganley, Davidge. 2. BOYLUNG ACTIVITIES

- a. A number of meetings have been held with Identity (1) and efforts are being made to step up the flow of material. Unfortunately, the effort is hampered by these complications:
 - (1) Monitors have not been able to pick up Identity (2) since January 2.
 - (2) Pixie newspapers formerly available through the HEFAIRY Smbassy can no longer be obtained from that source.
 - (3) Arrangements have not yet been made with OGIVE for an exchange of intelligence.

Our problem then is one of supplying Identity (1) writers with information which can be used as a basis for material. Efforts on the part of ZRHWTAL to arrange for an exchange of intelligence with OGIVE would be extremely helpful and if an examination of equipment here shows that Identity (2) can not be monitored a member of Identity (1) will be stationed in NACRID for the dual purpose of monitoring and attempting to work out a means with the boats running between MACRID and Pixieland to obtain copies of newspapers printed in Pixieland.

HOTE FOR Vill you inform that sextremely reluctant to take the boat assignment that we discussed in LCDRINK. I have told Identity (1) of present needs and have given them until February 23 to agree that hould go on a temporary basis or that an HINI-speaking Pixie with the necessary qualifications who has been cleared must be supplied.
