a. Action Reported by Field

- 1. The field reported that regular meetings were held with the two resident members of the Estional Committee for Free Albania (MCFA) in Athens and routine Committee affairs discussed.
- _). Chief of the Albanian Section in Athens, spent from 2-6 September in Bons discussing the current situation among the Albanian refugees in Rome with members of (Tond with the members of the MUFA in Rome. reported on the contacts with the Committee through the Biloku Kombeter Indipendent (BKI) and its plane for developing additional sources of information on the MCFA. The members of the MCFA expressed their desire that a U.S. reprecentative be againsed to Rose to act as linison channel for the Committee. They based their request on the Committee's need for guidance and for someone to represent ite interests in Weshington. The request confirms indirect reports that the Committee feels keenly the lack of direction and Wishes only to be told what is desired of it. The Committee members minimized the importance of the new emigre Committee, the National Democratic Committee for a Free Albania (NDCFA), and stated that it is impotent and without attraction to members of the NCFA, some of whom were initially thought likely to defect to the NDCFA. The members of NCFA expressed general satisfaction with the information being forwarded to them by Mr. Hasen Dosti, President of the NCFA, although they unde it clear that he was regarded as a weak leader and that they are not completely satisfied with him as the sole channel of communication.
- 3. Several meetings were held with Mr. Doeti, both in New York and Washington by members of the SE Division. Mr. Doeti reported that the Committee newspaper Shqiperia was published in Rome on schedule.
- 4. An approach made to Mr. Doeti by a member of the Yugoslav Consulate in New York was reported through Staff C to the Special Security Division and turned over to the FRI to handle.
- 5. Members of the SE Division audited the accounts of the HCFA in New York and found them to be in order.
- 6. On the basis of reports that Mesers. Abas Ermenje and Vesil Andoni, members of the dissident "Professor Group" of the Balli Kombetar Party (BK) and leaders of the
