## a. Action Reported by Field

1. During February Mr. Henry Cabot Lodge, Jr., the chief U. S. delegate to the UN, submitted to the UN data charging that Albania is guilty of maintaining forced labor camps. The material on Albania which Ambassador Lodge submitted was largely based on affidavits collected by \_\_\_\_\_\_ and by the Albanian Section in Athens from Albanian refugees now in Italy and Greece. In order to gain as much publicity as possible for the NCFA from the forced labor presentation, Mr. Hasan Dosti, President of the NCFA, sent a telegram to the Secretary General of the UN thanking him for the UN interest in exposing forced labor conditions in Albania. The telegram was then released to the press with a statement by Mr. Dosti.

2. Members of the SE Division met several times with Mr. Dosti during February to discuss Committee activities.

3. \_\_\_\_\_, Chief of the Albanian Section in Athens, and J who will replace \_\_\_\_\_ in March, wisited Rome in late February to discuss Committee activities and problems with members of the Executive Committee of the NCFA.

4. The newspaper <u>Shciperia</u>, which was printed in Rome on schedule, prominently featured the presentation to the UN of the material on forced labor in Albania.
