### a. Action Reported by Field

- 1. On 7 April a successful leaflet mission was flown over Albania. 2,750,000 leaflets were dropped over five major towns and populated areas on route. The leaflets dropped included 500,000 each of the January and April Obkock, 750,000 leaflets on the Malenkov fall, and 1,000,000 leaflets on the President's food offer. The aircraft flew over Tirans and Darres at approximately 250 feet and was able to discharge a larger number of leaflets than usual over these two towns.
- 2. We have requested \_\_\_\_\_\_and \_\_\_\_\_\_ to attempt to obtain through their lisison channels information regarding the reactions in Albania to our leaflets and radio programs from the Italian and French Legation personnel stationed in Tirana. We hope thereby to acquire on-the-spot reactions which will enable us to evaluate our P/W program realistically.
