a. Action Reported by Field.

1. On 28 November 1955 two successful leaflet raids were carried out over Albania utilizing the C-54 and B-26 aircraft. The C-54 raid was conducted against Lesh, Durres, Kavaje, Lushnje, Fier, Vlore and Highway areas enroute. A total of 12 million October OBKEEKS, one million November OBKEEKS and 1,000 pounds of a rticles were dropped. The B-26 raid was conducted against Leskovik, Korce, Cerave and areas enroute. In this raid a total of one-half million October OBKEEK's and one-half million November OBKEEKS were dropped. During these raids no enemy activity was encountered by the aircraft involved.

2. During this period no mail campaign activity was carried out although the field reported it is planning a new program in this field which they hope to initiate in the near future.

3. As a result of the November raids the present leaflet inventory has been considerably reduced.
