### a. Aation Reported by the Field

- 1. The radio continued its four regular transmissions over two frequencies simultaneously as well as its one or more "repeats", and transmittal of the random broadcast for about one hour daily also continued. Unfortunately due to other KUCLUB communications activity, the suddling of radio Tirane was discontinued on 21 November.
- 2. Efforts to obtain permission for AIFORT to reenter Greece continue through GALATRA. Efforts to secure permission from HEHADEOCK to recruit AIFIESE also continue.
- 3. All headquarters guidance on Mungary was utilized this month.

#### b. Pending Action

- 1. AIBEEN scheduled by USEP to depart for U.S. about the first week in January.
- 2. Although HHHADDOON is probably stalling with regard to our interest in AIPLEBE, a concrete answer is hoped for by the next reporting period and a PRQ II will be obtained on the latter.

### c. Braluation

- 1. The radio was clearly audible on the Greek-Albanian border (Konitan), despite the fact that the signal usually is weakening this time of year. The phase of the sumspots has evidently appreciably improved the transmissions characteristics.
- 2. A Greek-Albanian in remarked that the broadcasts were especially well prepared and showed the announcers had an excellent informational knowledge of present conditions in Albania. He believed the broadcasts originated in Italy.
