1. Taketore COATA, ex Japanese Minister of litate, was in Talpel from 7 to 13 May 1752 on a personal good will tour. He was accompanied by Ryulch KAJI, a famous Japanese scholar, former chief editorial writer of Asabi Shimbus, and Later chief of Asabi's Publishing Buresu. Accompanied by KAJI, OHATA made three calls on CHIANG Kal-chek but seconding to information recedied by a NYMAROW officer from the British Consul, CHIANG was extremely non-committed during each of these additiones. The British Consul stated that the reason for CHIANG's reluctance to talk freely to OGATA was "reliable" information in the possession of the Chinese Covernment indicating OGATA's companion. KAJI, to be a Falley Traveller Government indicating OGATA's companion, KAJI, to be a Fallow Traveller with strong Communist inclinations.
