1. HATOTANA Ichiro's illness will prevent him from taking an active part in politics in the next three or four years. Since TOSHIDA Shigeru is unwilling to stay in office for that length of time, he and HATOTAWA Ichiro have decided to turn the leadership of the Liberal Party over to - OGATA Taketors.

2. YOSHIDA Shigeru is expected to remain in office at least one year from the date of the ratification of the Treaty. He will then call a general election and name OGATA Taketora as his successor.

3. OLATA Taketors will be depurged very soon. He will not take any immediate part in politics. He is being urged to travel abroad, to study the international situation at first-hand and to prepare himself for his responsibilities.
