2. Re paragraphs 1 and 2: <u>OGATA Taketora</u> was a minister in the KOISO Cabinet who, in the early spring of 1944, was the central figure in the MIAO Pin Incident, an attempt at making peace with the Chungking Government. We would assume that this man is still very unpopular with military men.			
1. HATTORI Takushiro visited OGATA Taketora to explain his stand on rearmament, but does not believe that the conversation had much effect on OGATA. HATOYAMA Ichiro is far more serious and concerned with the subject of rearmament.			
2. OGATA is secretary to KOJIMA Kasuo and states that he is no longer working for ASAMI Press. (F-3)
