4. Because of his intense dislike for CHU, General HO Shih-li, chief of the Chinese Mission in Japan, has refused to renew his passport. As an alternative CHU has used his connections with a prominent Japanese, <u>OGATA Taketora</u> , and has obtained permission from the Japanese government to live in Japan permanently. CHU met OGATA through YANG Chung-hua, a former army commander in the WANG Ching-wei government and now a Third Force member.
