PERTINENT INFORMATION The following information is excerpted verbatim from the desk dossier - FE/1/Japan.  Hitoshi TAKEHASHI on May 7 in Hong Kong denied reports that he has been contacting Third Force Leaders in Hongkong in an official capacity. TAKEHASHI represents <u>Taketora OGATA</u> and is in Hong Kong to make preparations for the latter's trip to the Colony. It is also reported that, in conversation with Gen. HSU Tsung-tse, he has indicated that Japanese authorities would offer assistance in China's so-called democracy and freedom movement. Contacted by PANASIA, he denied the reports, saying that he is a private businessman. He is slated to return to Japan May 28. Informed sources in Hong Kong, stating that although he is not believed to be connected with OGATA, he is working for Japan's International Military Research Institute.
