<p>Cable from New Delhi excerpted verbatim from desk dossier - FE/1/Japan</p> <p><u>OGATA's</u> New Delhi press interview statement frontpaged; 3 papers quoted OGATA (who interviewed NEHRU Tuesday), saying that NEHRU inclined to believe Western Powers present policy increasing world tension and non-recognition MAO regime contributing factor. Said NEHRU felt unless democratic countries endeavor ease tension next 10-15 years there little prospect of maintaining world stability. Said stationing "foreign troops Japan by no means desirable position" adding under constitution enforced 1947 Japan not allowed military power according <u>Hindustan Times</u>. <u>Hindustan Standard</u> said to question if Japan's foreign policy likely to be different in any form from that of Allied powers. OGATA replied transfer of power to Japan more formal than actual adding there no limitations Japan's independence except that Japan acquired indepen- dence without means protecting foreign policy. <u>Hindustan Times</u>, <u>Hindustan Standard</u> quoted OGATA saying Japan's treaty with Formosa Government consequence San Francisco treaty adding Japan did not propose recognize MAO regime near future. Referring to May Day Tokyo riots said since YOSHIDA Government rep- resented majority Jap people demonstrations could not be regarded having support majority according to <u>Hindustan Standard</u>.</p>
