Therefing to the explanation of the plan given by Cabinet Secretary Several OMATA; the previously reported demand for appropriations for included in the appropriations asked for the expansion of the 'Cabinet Research and '. It was further explained that the proposed employment of a construction member of monitoring personnel as well as the necessary derivation and facilities for monitoring foreign broadcasts are also the habits of further study. Accordingly, Secretary General OMATA's the habits is major objective, the expansion and strengthening of investigative (intelligence) functions of the existing Cabinet Research Bots.

The original plans for the New Intelligence Organisation were based on be socialized that of X1,000,000,000 appropriation in the coming year's figure.
