<p>Dispatch from ()</p> <p>THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS EXCERPTED VERBATIM FROM A COPY RETAINED AT AREA DESK.</p> <p>Section C</p> <p>The Japanese Intelligence Service</p> <p>1. <u>OGATA Taketora</u> who concurrently holds the posts of Deputy Prime Minister And Chief Cabinet Secretary has shown himself to be the prime force in Japanese intelligence revival during the past month. Under his aegis, it appears likely that:</p> <p>a. The CRC will be expanded since its location in the government structure coincides with OGATA's aim of keeping the Japanese Intelligence Service under the direct control of the executive branch of the government.</p> <p>b. For the time being MURAI Jun, present chief of the CRC will retain his position.</p> <p>c. A large FBIS type organization will be established to handle radio monitoring, radio broadcasts and foreign news analysis on behalf executive branch of the government.</p> <p>2. The FBIS type organization has received considerable publicity in the Japanese press, most of it unfavorable...It is interesting to note that according to MURAI Jun, t is publicity derived from supposedly off-the-record remarks made to the press by OGATA himself.
