1. <u>Current Developments:</u>				
<p>a. <u>Antistrike Legislation Will Go to Diet:</u> The Government, following a period of apparent indecision, has decided to go ahead with an attempt to secure passage of legislation restricting strikes in the coal and power industries. On 13 June Left-wing Socialist AKAMATSU Isamu, Chairman of the Lower House Labor Committee, approached Deputy Prime Minister <u>OGATA Taketora</u> with a proposal that plans to present the legislation be cancelled. OGATA turned down the proposal and the present schedule calls for early consideration of the bill in the Diet. The Left-wing Socialist Party on 13 June decided to hold a joint meeting of party members of Labor, Cabinet and Judiciary Affairs committees to take up means of blocking the bill. On 14 June, Right-wing Socialist Party Chairman KAWAKAMI Jotaro announced that his party would join with the Left-wing Socialists in opposing the antistrike bill.</p>
