The conferees--Prime Minister YOSHIDA, Deputy Prime Minister <u>OGATA</u>, National Safety Agency Director KIMURA, and Finance Minister OHASAWARA--also decided to revise the NSA Law so that the mission of the National Safety Force would be enlarged to include defending the nation against foreign aggressors.
