## 1. Current Developments:

a. Next Diet Session Slated for November: Deputy Prime Minister OGATA, at a 14 Sept press interview, stated that the next Diet session will not be opened until November. Admitting that the government originally had spoken of mid-October as an appropriate time to reconvene the Diet, OGATA said that the time necessary to formlate the supplementary budget had become a factor in scheduling the next session. Moreover, the Deputy Prime Minister said, "Prime Minister YOSHIDA may go to the United States if the political situation is stabilized shortly", thus making an early Diet meeting impractical.
