"Nihon Keizai (Summary of Article)

"Sino-Japanese Bank Proposed by Leading Chinese Merchant

"Through former director Kenji Kodama of the defunct Yokohama Specie Bank (how the Bank of Tokyo), former president Shozo Murata of O.S.K., former Fianance Minister Retsu KAWADA, etc., Hu Wen Hu, a leader of Chinese merchants in the Southern areas, recently expressed his desire to the Japanese Government that a joint Sino-Japanese bank be set up in Japan to conduct banking business chiefly in Southeast Asia. Eagerly supporting the proposal, Prime Minister YOSHIDA and Deputy Prime Minister OGATA have already instructed all ministries concerned to examine it. It is said that Mr. Hu Wen Hu will visit Japan around the middle of next month to materialize the plan quickly.
