Deputy Prime Minister OGATA has disclosed that a cabinet reshuffle will not come until the draft budget has been put into final shape. This would probably make it about 15 January. He also said that in giving final form to the budget the government and the Liberal Party "will not make any special overtures" to the Progressive Reform Party.
