At a meeting of the Japanese Cabinet on 14 January 1954, the following points were decided in connection with the reorganization of the Japanese Police system:</p> <p>.....</p> <p>d. That the Prefectural Police would be under the control of Prefectural Public Safety Commissions, appointed by the Prefectural Governors, with the exception that the new police agency, which in effect will be an expanded NRP headquarters, will control activities in certain categories, as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(1) Large-scale natural disasters</li> <li>(2) Rural riots</li> <li>(3) Any incidents affecting national interests, or which would possibly have any national repercussions.</li> </ol> <p>.....</p> <p>3. <u>Field Comment.</u> On 20 January 1954 the Nippon Times quoted Deputy Prime Minister <u>OGATA Taketora</u> as stating that the question of appointment, instead of election, of the Prefectural Governors was under study by the Local Administrative System Investigation Committee, as was also the practically unlimited scope potential scope proposed in subparagraph (3).</p>
