Shipbuilding Probes: Investigations into irregularities, rebates and alleged bribery in connection with government subsidies to the shipping industry continue to embarrass the Administration. In Diet committee hearings on 15 Feb, Left-wing Socialists took the lead in attempting to build a picture of widespread corruption...The attack moved on to State Minister ONO Bamboku, who also has headed a shipping firm. The Left-wing Socialist questioner asked Deputy Prime Minister <u>OGATA</u> whether he would ask ONO to "assume his moral responsibility" by resigning from the company post.
