The reason why the plan of HOSHINA Zenshiro to have the Japanese Air Force placed within the Second Staff Office of the National Safety Agency (NSA) was rejected in favor of the establishment of the new Third Staff Office was that HOSHINA consulted only Japanese officials. HOSHINA approached Vice Premier <u>OGATA Taketora</u>, Chief Cabinet Secretary FUKUNAGA Kenji, and NSA officials KIMURA Tokutaro, UEMURA Kentaro, and KASUHARA Keikichi; he neglected, however, to approach FEAF.</p>
