Left Socialist FUJIWARA Michiko touched off the debate in the Upper House Budget Committee by demanding that the government get indemnity for the 23 Japanese fishermen who returned from Bikini waters with radiation poisoning. Though three officials replied for the government, none committed himself. Deputy Prime Minister <u>OGATA</u>: "No detailed report has come to us yet.
