Shipping Scandals: In the shipping scandals now under investigation, procurators on 19 Mar arrested YOKOTA Aisaburo, president of the Yamashita Steamship Company. Among his papers, they found a set of diaries containing names of scores of political leaders, mostly Liberals, to whom YOKOTA's company allegedly gave large political donations.
