The conservative merger drive made headway yesterday. Three Liberal Leaders-- Deputy Prime Minister <u>OGATA</u> , Constitution Research Council Chairman KISHI, and Political Research Committee Adviser ISHIBASHI--met secretly to push the project. While the Liberals have officially taken a wait-and-see position, most of them favor a tieup with the Progressive Reformists and the Japan Liberals.
