This information was obtained from ( ) by ( ) at ( ) office in Kyoto on 23 June 1953. Although largely academic now, it may appreciate in value when and if OGATA becomes Premier or even more so if Deputy Premier. It is interesting to note that ( ) states he will not himself join such a new organization because "it would hamper his ability to operate as an intelligence officer." Such an attitude on the part of a person of ( ) experience in Japanese intelligence circles, plus the standing antipathy of other Ministries and Agencies toward the CRC, augurs rough sledding for an agency such as is described herein if it is established.

We are giving this no local dissemination because the past close relationship between OGATA and ( ) makes such dissemination inadvisable; it would be too easy for our gentle readers to make an accurate conjecture as to the source. In this instance, such conjecture would probably be just as accurate in Washington, and so we recommend no dissemination to the field and no Washington dissemination unless the source is hooked up.
