1. Circumstances of Meeting

On 24 November the wife of POCAPON got in touch by telephone with [ ] in order to conclude arrangements for the repayment of the "loan" of \$450.00 made to [ ] in June 1955. [ ] volunteered to go to the house of POCAPON.

2. Return of funds

Wife of POCAPON appeared to be extremely pleased and thankful for the financial help rendered which enabled [ ] to travel extensively in the United States in addition to giving him a sense of security. [ ] was handed the sum of ¥162,000 in Japanese currency in full payment of the \$450.00 loan. [ ] impressed upon POCAPON's wife that he stood willing and able to further financially assist [ ] in case extra finances were needed for a contemplated trip through Europe on his trip back to Japan in July 1956.

3. POCAPON

POCAPON was characterized as a person who refused to take a risk in supplying dollars to his youngest son and that he was by nature a scrupulously honest type of person. POCAPON refused to consider utilization of the ASAHI newspapers offices in the U.S. for funds because of this reason.
