Nine local newspapers have organized a "Union of Newspapers Opposing Civilian Microwave Facilities" and on 11 Nov 1953 representatives of the Union handed a protest against the SHORIKI plan to Postal Service Minister TSUKADA at the Dai-Ichi Seimei Building in Tokyo, when he was attending a National Mayors Conference. On the morning of 14 Nov they called on Vice Premier <u>OGATA Taketora</u> and left him with a protest against the use of foreign capital in Japanese television.
