ACTION REQUIRED: None, for information only.

1.   returned to   Station, on 29 May 1957, some of the material previously passed to POGAPON prior to the latter's death. Material believed to be of KUBARK origin is forwarded herewith as Enclosure No. 1 for Headquarters disposition; other material, such as copies of U.S. News and World Report and other overt U.S. publications, are being returned to   for the latter's retention or destruction.

2. For the record,   stated that the documents returned on 29 May probably constitute the majority, if not all, of the existing documents he assumes came from KUBARK; other material might have been available but is now either lost (an unlikely case in that   was the person responsible for settling POGAPON's effects and nothing had been disturbed until the former's return to Japan) or had inadvertently been burned as part of kindling material for his Ofuro (bath) at home.   Station will make no other attempts to recover further documents unless advised to the contrary by Headquarters.

3. For Headquarters assistance in case there is a necessity of checking on the exact material involved, forwarded herewith as Enclosure No. 2 is a copy of OSB/ID Memo dtd 6 Sept 1956 which references the basic correspondence concerning material passed to POGAPON.
