1. We note that in paragraph 2D of reference dispatch Chlbrecht is described as a security man for LCCASSOCK. A previous report on Chlbrecht (ERLM 955), 7 July) stated that he was resigning in September. We are interested in this case and would appreciate being informed in greater detail concerning Chlbrecht's present status. In view of the fact that he is a known ZIPPER-its and planning to join (figurities, of dubious reputation, after he leaves LCCASSOCK, it would seem that it would be advisable to begin to disongage him from his security duties with _____ prior to his actual departure. Have any steps been taken to do this? We would also like to know the actual date of Chlbrecht's separation from the group.

2. In the same paragraph it is also reported that Ohlbrecht and Nuchen write situation reports and evaluations of conditions in the NDR for/Remain. We wonder if these analyses are similar to that forwarded with EMEA-5866 which was stated to have been written by a member of the staff. If, on the other hand, these studies contain material which reflects the NURARE-sponsored activities of the LCGARSOFF group, we would be very interested in seeing them. In either case we would appreciate the case officer's view of the value of these studies as intalligence reports. If it appears that they contain useful positive intelligence, the case officer could perhaps forward copies of several reports which could then be analysed and evaluated by the appropriate scotion here.
