- (8) As a result of continued contacts between BANCH and a Department of the Army source in Europe during September and October 1962, the following additional information has been developed regarding BANCH's activities, West German Intelligence Service (MIS) operations, and identification of WIS personnel.
- # BARCH has somitted to source that he is, in fact, currently employed by the West Carmen Invalligance Service. His conversations with source and the type of questions which he put to source lead to the conclusion that BARCH has been working on the Middle Kast/Africa deak of the WCIS. RARCH is single and list; his Middle as Monich 19, Suedliche Auffahrtsallee 56, Telephone 572596. Although he declined to give source his office telephone number, he identified his place of employment as being in Monich, Warmany
- RADICE was scheduled to leave for Cairo, Egypt, via ship from Naples, Italy, on about 28 October 1952. He told source that the WIIS has been "cooperating" with the Egyptian intelligence Service (EIS) for the past four years and that he was being posted to Egypt to head a tesm of four West Germans who would serve an "technical advisors" to the KIS. technical subjects were involved. (MARCH visited the Minifon company in Frankfurt, Germany ent 20 October 1962 which indicates that listening devices may also be involved. - BANCH revealed that Baron von VELETH, operating under journalist over, was the chief WILS representative in Cairo prior to his death.   - (8) From all that him transpired during the past several mouths, it now appears that MANNE & reason for establishing and maintaining contact with our source is the fold: to develop a shallow commercial cover for his forthcoming pour in Chiro and to develop commercial contacts in the Middle Kest area which may prove financially profitable to him personally. Through source, little was able to establish contact with a number of West German firms.
