1. Subject was brought to the attention of MERKER when [] first learned of OLBRUECK's departure from Germany. At that time, we asked for details of connections to Egypt, background, etc.

2. From POB records it was determined that Erich OLBRUECK, V-7902, former leader of UV-7900, BV-80, GVH was issued a Kennkarte under the name of Heinrich ALLMANN. KK No. HE III H 580 278, issued 12 March 51. ALLMANN is described as an engineer by occupation; 187 cm tall; blue-green eyes; born 20 January 1911 in Breslau, Germany; lives Jungmannstr. 25, Frankfurt/Main. Driver's license No. 79/51 was issued to ALLMANN in Frankfurt/Main on 12 April 1951. ALLMANN was also issued a 7924 Army Procurement Team ID Card No. AT-1131, 7 March 51. The Kennkarte issued to Erich OLBRUECK is recorded as No. B VII 25 788 and states he was born 20 January 1911 in Gelsenkirchen, Germany; residence: 35 Heimbacherstr, Fulda. Zugangsgenehmigung was requested for Fulda. Another alias used by OLBRUECK was Erich PONS and was issued 7924 Army Procurement Team ID Card No. AT-1071, 11 May 50.

3. As leader of UV-7900, he was involved in positive operations against the Sov Zone of Germany. He was involved with JUPITER proposal Nos. 80/H and 635/H.

4. MERKER finally reported the following pursuant to our request:

"OLBRUECK traveled to Egypt during the early part of 1952. He is a former German Army Reserve officer who later became an SS-Sturmabfuhrer (Major) in the RSHA. He is married and has two children. OLBRUECK personally volunteered the information that he is going to Egypt as a representative of a Swiss firm and will attempt to build up export trade with the entire Near East.

"It is known to us that OLBRUECK has personal connections to General FARMBACHER and other members of the German Advisory Mission in Egypt. We also know that he established contact with them. However, we do not know if this contact was personal or established for commercial reasons. We doubt that he is working with the Advisory Mission; however, that is also in the realm of possibility.

"OLBRUECK is a former member of this organization who resigned at his own request during the beginning of 1952."
