1. At the 10 April meeting, [ ] submitted three background and personality reports which are being forwarded by separate dispatch.

2. [ ] requested traces on Erich M. Olbruch, Munchen 23, Barlachstr. 6/VII, Ru 36755 (this info from subject's card). Subject is 50-55 years old, 6'2", 220 lbs. He is married and has two step children - one daughter and one son. The daughter is married to a Moroccan. Olbruch is a German businessman representing several German firms (names unknown, will check) on the same basis as [ ]. Subject is well known at the German Embassy and has introduced [ ] to the German Commercial Attache. [ ] sees both of the above socially at least once or twice a week.

3. [ ] reported that he was not sure that his wife and son would be able to join him in Khartoum. When [ ] wife took the son for shots, the doctor recommended against his taking any shots until he had checked with the previous doctor who had taken care of the son during a recent illness which started in Tehran. No other facts were available and [ ] did not have a clear idea of what was wrong. [ ] was requested to write and get all the details.

4. [ ] morale was understandably very low as a result of this development and [ ] felt it would not be profitable to press him operationally. The rest of the evening was spent talking about old friends and having something to eat. [ ] seemed in better spirits when the meeting ended.

5. [ ] was paid LS 86 for rent of an operational vehicle for three months. He was also instructed to do everything possible to expedite delivery of his QP vehicle.
