SUBJECT: Erich DIEBUECK, German National in the Sudan

REFERENCE: ACBI-CO, 26 September 1960

1. This Agency is also in receipt of information which indicates that Subject is an agent of the West German Intelligence Service. It should be emphasized, however, that the information which we possess is speculative in nature and has not been substantiated.

2. The basis for the supposition regarding DIEBUECK are that he lives beyond his apparent means, he makes frequent trips in and out of the Sudan, he has a wide circle of friends, especially Sudanese and he is a close friend of Richard POML, commercial and Cultural Attache of the West German Embassy in the Sudan.

3. Subject, who is or was also known as Heinrich ADHAN and Erich POML, was born 20 January 1911 in Breslau. He is married to a German widow and has a step-son and daughter. The son is a student at a German university and the daughter is married to the son of the well known Moroccan rebel, Abdel Karim, and now resides in Cairo.
