1. (S) A Department of the Army source submitted a report on
4 July 1962 concerning a discussion which he had had on that date with
Germany, Südliche Auffahrtsallee 56. The substance of the report was
as follows:

a. BAUCH and one Carol ROMAN are establishing a firm in
Beirut, Lebanon to do, as BAUCH put it, "topographic reproduction" work.
ROMAN was described only as "formerly a pilot in Syria." (S-3)

b. Source first became acquainted with BAUCH some 10 years
ago in Cairo where the latter frequently turned up, sometimes using an
alias. According to source, BAUCH is, actually a Gehlen agent and the
plan to establish a firm in Beirut may be a new cover for intelligence
activities in that area. (S-2)

c. BAUCH is a close friend of Rolf ENKEL, former German
rocket expert currently employed by Bobrini Parodi del Pino in Rome,
and of Colonel KRIEGER, Military Attaché in Cairo. In
his conversation with source on 4 July 1962, BAUCH also acknowledged
that he knows Erich OLSNECK, suspected Gehlen agent in Khartoum, Sudan.
BAUCH's comments indicated that he is well acquainted with the inner
workings of the West German Ministry of Defense. (S-2)
