SUBJECT: Erich M. OLBRUECK

1. Reference is made to your memorandum ACSI-OO, 9.4, which was received in this office on 17 May 1963, subject: Erich M. OLBRUECK.

2. This Agency is almost certain that Subject is currently working for the West German Intelligence Service (BND) since he is known to have worked for the BND earlier and since they requested a BDC check on him in August 1962. OLBRUECK worked for the BND as a field case officer from circa 1949 until 1952 when he allegedly resigned for personal reasons. Subject has also aroused the attention of this Agency in Khartoum because of his high standard of living and activities which appear to have intelligence connotations.

3. We would appreciate receiving any further information that comes to your attention regarding Subject.
