This Agency is almost certain that Subject is currently working for the West German Intelligence Service (MED) since he is known to have worked for the BMD earlier and since they requested a BDC cheek on him in August 1962. CLBRUKCK worked for the BID as a field case officer from circa 1949 until 1953 when he allogedly resigned for personal reasons. Subject has also aroused the attention of this Agency in Enartesm because of his high standard of living and activities which appear to have intelligence counctations.
- 3. We would appreciate receiving any further information that comes to your attention regarding Subject.
