Reference is made to our report of 25 September 1950 concerning [redacted] and to that of 2 October 1950 which stated that [redacted] was the [redacted] in regular contact with the Bulgarian Legation in Rome and [redacted] in [redacted] Bulgaria [redacted].

Subsequent to the above allegations [redacted] attempts have been made to either confirm or deny, or obtain further details which would identify the contact that subject has engaged in [redacted] with the Bulgarian Legation. A report dated 15 September 1951 from a [redacted] source advised that subject maintains contacts with the Bulgarian Legation in Rome, but there is no proof that he is working for this organization.

Further checks through local authorities brought forth no additional pertinent information on or last other than the fact that he was visited in September 1954 in Italy by his parents who reside in Bulgaria.

Regarding the Department's CI of 23 July 1953 enclosing three reports from CIA Headquarters dated 15 September 1953, 14 October 1953 and 10 Jan 1954 regarding an evaluation of the veracity and of all the information relating to subject it is suggested that the Department request this information directly from CIA Headquarters.
