SUBJECT: Alleged Soviet Attempt to Purchase American Surplus Stocks

The following is an unprocessed copy of our report No. F-5844, which is being sent to you in the belief that it will be of interest:

"The following report, from a conservative Prench industrialist source, is submitted despite its general vagueness, for whatever use it may have in offering leads or supplying checks.

ol. The United States has demanded payment in dollars for the purchase of surplus stocks. As Switzerland is the only country in Europe with large quantities of dollars to dispose of, various countries are negotiating with her for the purchase of American material; the Swiss to pay in dollars and the other countries to reimburse them in their own currency. of the clauses for the purchase of American material states of the clauses for the purchase of American material states specifically that it cannot be resold. This prohibition hits Russia particularly. The latter is trying, through the intermediary of Central European countries, to buy American stocks. She will pay in gold, which will be deposited to the credit of Swiss bankers, who will then give dollars for the realization of these purchases. From all sides come reports of negotiations in process. Several names of individuals have been reported in this connection, but with no precise indications of the part they play. Briefly the situation is:

- The purchasing agent for the USSR has arrived in Berne with the Hungarian Boonomic Mission.
- He has made contact with Franconi, a Swiss expert of Saurer Transport.
- 8. Bolles, of the Hotel des Bergues, is also following the situation closely. He works through the intermediary of Timer, a Rungarian living in Exrich in the Hotel

All information concerning Bolian is interesting for the following reasons: He gambled against the franc; he is probably the intermediary for German financiers; he is cultivating all the English contacts he can in order to have himself taken off the black list. One should not be led astray by the fact that he is on good terms with officials of the American Legation and with you Sterger, Swiss Minister of Police and Justicey
