1. Personal data:

2. In March 1948 Subject moved with his wife, Elizabeth FREUDENSTEIN, daughter of Carlo, 51 years old, housewife, from Basle to Milan. He was in possession of passport No. 005012 dated 19 February 1946 issued by the Legation of the Republic of Latvia in Bern, valid until 17 February 1951, with visa issued by the Italian Consulate in Basle dated 9 April 1948 valid for two months, issued for business reasons. Upon reaching Milan, Subject took lodgings at the Hotel Principe e Savoia and announced his presence to the Milan Questura, obtaining authorization to sojourn in Italy, permit No. 4784, dated 3 June 1948, for 70 days. Later, following the intervention in Subject's favor by MARAZZA and LEDA with the then Director General of the P.S., FERRARI, Dispatch No. 443/56863 of 17 June 1948, authorized Subject to sojourn permanently in Italy for business reasons.
3. On 12 July 1949 he was issued by the Ministry of Interior a stateless person certificate (not on Italian passport) with an exit and re-entry visa for Italy valid for six months and for more than one trip. This concession was sponsored by the prelate Don Carlo BUCCO through high personalities of the Ministry of Defense and of the Ministry of Interior and favored to such a point as to obtain from competent office of the Direction General of the P.S. the transmittal to the Milan Questura of the blank (model 0545) of the above mentioned document. Notwithstanding this, Subject refused the certificate as stateless person desiring to maintain Latvian citizenship for himself and his wife.
4. Some months ago Subject moved from the Hotel Principe e Savoia to Via Durini 20, Milan, where he occupied an apartment rented to him by Mrs. Gally ROSCHINI CASSELLARCO whom he met in Switzerland during the war and with whom he is on very friendly terms. Subject does not do any work and lives on a scale which indicates ample means. He opened a checking account with the main office of the Credito Lombardo, Via Santoni 14, in Milan, from which monthly he withdraws one million lire for his expenses.

Subject owns two luxury automobiles: a nine passenger Hertz license 28384/ZH (CH), which he uses for his personal use and Packard, license 3949 RL (F) which he recently presented to Istituto Lattilattini di Guerra through Don GNOCCHI, to whom he also presented the Fessano Castle which he bought shortly after he came to Italy. Subject's contributions to the Istituto Lattilattini are frequent and large.
6. Subject is very well known in Switzerland in financial and industrial circles. He is a shareholder of several Swiss industrial and commercial organizations, among which the Geneva Gas Comp. Subject has vast real estate properties in Cannes and also has several investments in South America, French colonies, France, Belgium, and Holland.
7. Subject is a very distinguished person, talkative, intelligent, very well educated, who speaks Russian, French, and German well and is in contact with many Italian and foreign personalities. In France during the war he allegedly subsidized the Maquis and in Switzerland was on friendly terms with Hon. JUCONT of the I. aiding the Italian partisan forces.
