OLEYAN was suspected during the war of being connected with a gang of Balts and White Russians (including the notorious BEREDZE) who worked for the German SD in Paris by bringing into Smitzerland and selling there international shares, currencies, and gold confiscated by the Germans from Jews in France. In this way, he amassed an enormous fortune, but Allied and Swiss investigations against him were forestalled for years by his extremely able and influential lawyer, Proferroe, lin Zurich, who kept subject in a sanatorium most of the time, claiming that he was too ill to go to court. He finally procured a vise for him which permitted his leaving the country for Italy.
