| <p>1. According to a fairly reliable source, "CIC Linz," on 15 February 1951, confiscated 500,000 Thiele fuses belonging to EURAM AG of Zurich at Mastil & Co., Linz. According to previous reports received from the same source, the 500,000 Thiele fuses were to be shipped to Yugoslavia and/or Italy upon completion of current negotiations between an international syndicate in possession of the fuses and the potential purchasers. The fuse syndicate was formed by Michael <u>OLIAN</u> (OLIAN) of the INTERNATIONAL CREDIT ANSTALT, Vaduz, AROPIFA AG of Zurich, and Hans GAZDA of EURAM AG. This syndicate had, again according to the same source, carried on negotiations for the sale of the fuses with Brazil, Sweden, Yugoslavia, and Italy, but never with satellite countries.</p> | | | | |
