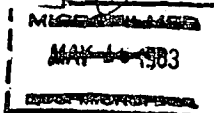

1. Subject continues to visit Rome where he lodges at the leading hotels or also in the Villa Madama area. Towards the end of 1951 he maintained contact with the Israeli Minister to Italy, Dr. Shlomo GINOSSAR, resident at 33 Via di Villa Massimo. It was reported that OLIANS was in contact with GINOSSAR regarding exportation of arms to Italy, but subsequent investigations did not confirm this allegation.
2. OLIANS' mistress, Annunziata BRUSADELLI, since the end of 1951 resides at 77 Via Archimede in an apartment rented by OLIANS; BRUSADELLI's former abode was 7 Piazza delle Muse. The latter apartment was passed by OLIANS to the family of Franco BERDINI, one of the SCALERA Film administrators; OLIANS is the principal stockholder in SCALERA Films. BRUSADELLI, from 11 to 14 June 1951 was in the company of former Colonel Charles POLETTI (US AMG Governor for the Lombardy Region) in Milan.
3. OLIANS travels frequently between Venice, Milan, and Rome. He is a lavish spender and is extremely wealthy probably as a result of illegal commercial deals. OLIANS' previous reports of criminal convictions in Switzerland and France have been confirmed. In November 1951 the Vatican police requested information concerning OLIANS.
