On 19 November 1952, ST and H experimentation was carried on in Building 13, Room 20, with [REDACTED] by [REDACTED] also present was [REDACTED] who had joined this group for the first time. In view of the fact that [REDACTED] was new, the writer again went into some detail on the [REDACTED] work and tested [REDACTED] on the falling back technique and hand rising technique.

In both instances [REDACTED] responded very well. Immediately thereafter, [REDACTED], using the eye fixation technique, succeeded in obtaining a good hypnotic situation in regard to [REDACTED]

The rest of the session was spent in a general discussion of the hypnotic technique and routine tests for depth and induction. In this connection, it should be noted that [REDACTED] proved to be an excellent subject and with [REDACTED] was able to accomplish several fairly advanced tests.

As noted previously, neither [REDACTED] advanced over their previous induction points and very clearly demonstrated again that they were not good subjects.
