The Zentrale of the English-controlled Polish Intelligence Service in Stockholm functions as has been proved, over the Baltic area, perhaps too over Finland, against Russia and doubtless also against Germany. The Leiter of the Polish Intelligence Service is the former Polish Oberst. Iwanow Piotr. He is provided with a Mandschukuo-Passport as secretary to the Japanese Military-Attache, Oberst. Onodera. Oberst Onodera declared to the Abw. III F in Stockholm: he still received information from Moscow. (Before the war Onodera was Japanese Military-Attache in Riga, probably at that time made contact with Polish Intelligence officers and collaborated with the Japanese Consulate in Riga, who, as it can be proved, conducted espionage against Germany.)
