- 1. Reference report was read with interest. In attempting to run a name trace on Subject, we found immsscrable cards on fou OPIZ. Would it be possible for you to provide us with subject's first name and birth date so that we can re-check our files for all likely traces on him?
- 2. Of interest is the fact that MIEA 266, dated 6 March 1953 (RE and COM only), reported that according to Heins MIEASER, chief of the LfV Bremen, fine OFFIZ had been relieved as director of MIEASET, Hamburg.
 MIEASER stated that he apparently was not qualified to set up and run the office; that he was careless about security, having sent classified letters through the regular mails. According to this dispatch, shortly after the MIEASET had been set up in Hamburg, the Hamburger Volkszeitung, the Communist paper there, announced the address and mission of the "Stelle" in one of its issues.
