A further check of Headquarters files has revealed the following additional traces on Subject:

1. Heinz Paul OPITZ, appointed Krim. Polizeirat at Stettin in July 1933; Politische Polizei at Hqrs. of SS Reichsfuehrer and Chef der Deutschen Polizei in Ministry of the Interior in 1939; promoted to Hilfs Krim. Kom. in June 1943 at Kripoleitstelle, Berlin; Amtgehilfe in August 1943; Ausweis No. 26249; resided at Lynarstrasse 21, Berlin Wilmerdorf in 1939. (Undated SHAEF card)
2. MFKW 11751, 3 December 1951: OPITZ, fmr, SS Stubaf. and Reg.-and Krim. Rat, Generalgrenz Inspekteur in IV E 1, RSHA, May 1943; official of IV F 1 RSHA in October 1943; born about 1903.
3. MFLA 8603, 19 October 1951: Requests traces on Paul OPITZ, born 17 September 1897, during war Chief, Zollgrenzschutz; now salesman for a Hamburg leather company.
4. In EGGA 431, 18 June 1953, OPITZ is described as follows: ca. 1.65 m tall, slim build, scar on right side of chin, wears gold-rimmed glasses. Agreeable and smooth talker.
