1. We would like to compliment _____ on the general accuracy of his observations concerning Paul *OPITZ (born 17 September 1897 in Bad Schmiedeberg, Kreis Wittenberg), Chief of the Kuenast. Hamburg.

- 2. Paragraphs 3 and 4 of the Attachment to Reference and the comments on Opitz's habits are in complete accord with our own observations. There is a truly astonishing lack of cooperation between the LfV and the Kuenast. Concerning the BfV, there is good reason to believe that Opitz harbors some resentment toward his parent organization. Part of this has administrative and financial origins, but is also partly due to a difference in philosophy concerning operations. Having dealt with Opitz now for many months, both and I are struck by the careful and detailed approach he employs on matters of minute importance, by his suspicious attitude toward everything and all, by his repetitiousness and the singularly monotonous manner of his delivery. While these characteristics do not detract from his ability as a counter-intelligence officer, they make contact with him quite a trial and I would imagine that Opitz makes demands on the BfV for tracing and other support which the latter does not have the manpower to provide. I was present recently at a meeting between Opitz and Regierungsrat Pietsch of the BfV where, although the atmosphere was pleasant enough, Pietsch made it pretty clear to me that one day in Hamburg is usually quite enough for him.
 - 3. Our own relations with Opitz continue satisfactorily. The
