MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: ASCASSOWARY Contact with Soviet Official at the United Nations

- 1. ANCASSONARY-2 telephoned the undersigned about 1400 hours today, 28 October 1958, and stated he wanted to report officially the following incident:
- a. Iven HOSBELIVEIB, associate editor of LITERATERNA HAZENA (supplement to the AECASSCHARY newspaper SUCHASMA UEDATEA), the is visiting in the United States, teld AECASSCHARY-2 that he was going to try to contact Inhomyr DMCESSCO, presently with a Soviet Ukrainian mission at the United States, for the purpose of discussing and contanging literary vises.

 DMCESSCO is a well-known author in the Soviet Ukraina.
- b. ARCASSUMARY-2, desiring to be fully source of concelly what would transpire, setted ARCASSUMARY-27 to accompany ROBBELLYERS. A latter of introduction in which they presented their desire to meet with IMITERIES. was prepared and handed to INU IVARW at the United Bations who introduced. himself as the Secretary of the Soviet Ministry of Foreign Affairs. IVANV gave ARCASONANT-27 and EDSERIVERS a very condial reception, presided to deliver the letter to Darries and sesured them of a reply.
- c. AFLASIONARY-ST told IVAROV that even though the Soviets refer to them as bourgeois maticulists, etc., they still hoped a meeting for the enchange of literary ideas would be possible. WARW replied that there is no reason sky they cannot meet for a friendly chat.
- 2. ANCASSONANT-2 enid he wested this contact to be made a matter of official record, in the event the meeting was observed "by your people", so that no compiratorial significance be attached to the contact at some later date.
