1. On 28 October 1958, Ivan MOSHELLIVETS and Lubomir Orest OATHESKY presented to Yuri Aleksandrovich IVANOV, advisor with the Ekrainian delegation to the 13th Session of the United Nations General Assembly, a latter of introduction in which they presented their desire to meet with Lyubomyr Dmitrievich DMITERMO, alternate delegate with the Ukrainian delegation to the 13th Session of the UNIOA and well-known author in the Soviet Ukraine. IVANOV gave Subjects a cordial reception and promised to deliver the letter to DMITERMO. ORTHISKY told IVANOV that even though the Soviets refer to them as bourgeois nationalists, they hoped it would be possible to meet with DMITERMO to exchange literary views. IVANOV replied there was no reason why a meeting could not be arranged for a friendly that between fellow Ukrainians. To date, however, there has been no reply to the letter handed IVANOV and no meeting has taken place.

Ivan KNAMELIVETS, is associate editor of Literaturma Hazeta, (Literary Casette), literary supplement to Suchaena Ukraina, (Contemporary Ukraine), which newspapers are published in Funich, Cormany, as organs of the ZF/CAVK (Foreign Representation of the Ukraining Supreme Liberation Council), of interest to this Agency. KOSHILIVETS presently is visiting in the United States from Munich for a period of 2-3 months.
- 3. ORTHESET and TOSHELIVETS are not aware of this agency's interest in their organisation and since this agency gave no direction for their contact with the Soviet delegates, it is requested that this be treated
